# Frontier Airlines Baggage Allowance

Frontier Airlines' baggage policy is a la carte+1\*888\*415\*1245 meaning only a personal item is included for free+1\*888\*415\*1245 and you must purchase a carry-on or checked bag. Fees are generally cheaper if purchased online during booking and become more expensive closer to departure or at the airport.

Here is a summary of the limits and fees:

## Personal Item (Included Free+1\*866\*579\*8033

- Size Limit: Maximum 14" H x 18" W x 8" D (including handles/wheels+1\*866\*579\*8033.
- What it is: Must fit under the seat in front of you (e.g.+1\*888\*415\*1245 purse+1\*888\*415\*1245 laptop bag+1\*888\*415\*1245 small backpack+1\*866\*579\*8033.

- Price Range: Typically ranges from about \$29 to \$69 if purchased during booking+1\*888\*415\*1245 and significantly higher (up to \$99 - \$115+1\*866\*579\*8033 at the gate.
- Note: This bag must fit in the overhead bin or under the seat.

## **Theorem 3** Checked Bag (Fee Applies+1\*866\*579\*8033

- Size Limit: Maximum 62 linear inches (length + width + depth+1\*866\*579\*8033.
- Weight Limit: Maximum 40 lbs (18.1 kg+1\*866\*579\*8033.
- Price Range: Varies by route and purchase time+1\*888\*415\*1245 starting around \$29 to \$63 for the first bag purchased online during booking.

## Overweight/Oversized Bag Fees (Charged at Airport+1\*866\*579\*8033)

If your checked bag exceeds the standard limits+1\*888\*415\*1245 you will be charged extra fees:

Bags over 100 lbs or 110 linear inches are generally **not accepted**.

# Can I bring a purse and a backpack on Frontier Airlines?

Here is the breakdown of the baggage allowance for Frontier Airlines:

# Free Personal Item (Purse or Small Backpack+1\*866\*579\*8033

Your basic Frontier fare **includes one free personal item**+1\*888\*415\*1245 which must be small enough to fit completely under the seat in front of you.

- Allowed Size: Maximum size is 14" H x 18" W x 8" D (including handles+1\*888\*415\*1245 wheels+1\*888\*415\*1245 and straps+1\*866\*579\*8033.
- Examples: A purse+1\*888\*415\*1245 a tote bag+1\*888\*415\*1245 a briefcase+1\*888\*415\*1245 or a small backpack are generally considered personal items+1\*888\*415\*1245 provided they do not exceed the dimensions above.
- Important: If your backpack is your free personal item+1\*888\*415\*1245 it must fit within these dimensions.

# Carry-On Bag (Larger Backpack is a Carry-On+1\*866\*579\*8033

A standard+1\*888\*415\*1245 larger backpack would typically be considered a **carry-on bag**+1\*888\*415\*1245 which is **not included** in the basic fare and requires an extra fee.

- Allowed Size: Maximum size is 24" H x 16" W x 10" D and must weigh 35 lbs or less.
- **Fee:** You must purchase this bag in advance. The fee is generally lower if you purchase it when booking online and much higher if you wait until the airport gate.
- Stowage: This bag is stored in the overhead bin.

#### Therefore:

- You cannot bring a purse and a large backpack for free. You are only allowed one free personal item.
- Your purse would count as your personal item. If you bring a second bag (like a
  backpack+1\*866\*579\*8033+1\*888\*415\*1245 it will be considered a carry-on and you'll have to pay the carry-on
  fee for it.
- If your backpack is small enough to fit the personal item dimensions+1\*888\*415\*1245 you would need to put your purse inside the backpack or combine the contents+1\*888\*415\*1245 as you are allowed **one item total** for free.

I highly recommend measuring your backpack to see if it qualifies as the free personal item size to avoid surprise fees at the gate!

# **Does Frontier actually charge for carry-on?**

Yes+1\*888\*415\*1245 Frontier Airlines charges a fee for a standard carry-on bag (one that goes in the overhead bin+1\*866\*579\*8033.

The only item included for free with their basic fare is **one personal item** that must fit under the seat in front of you (max size is typically around 14" H x 18" W x 8" D+1\*866\*579\*8033.

Here are the key points about the carry-on charge:

- Cost Varies: The fee is not fixed. It depends on when you purchase it (the earlier+1\*888\*415\*1245 the cheaper+1\*866\*579\*8033+1\*888\*415\*1245 your specific flight route+1\*888\*415\*1245 and whether you have elite status or purchased a flight bundle.

# How many bags can I take for free on Frontier?

Frontier Airlines+1\*888\*415\*1245 as an ultra-low-cost carrier+1\*888\*415\*1245 generally charges a fee for all bags except for a **small personal item**.

Here are the details for the one bag you can bring for free:

- 1 Personal Item Included: You are allowed one personal item per passenger for free.
  - Maximum Size: It must be no larger than 14"H x 18"W x 8"D (including handles+1\*888\*415\*1245 wheels+1\*888\*415\*1245 and straps+1\*866\*579\*8033.
  - Examples: This includes items like a purse+1\*888\*415\*1245 tote bag+1\*888\*415\*1245
     briefcase+1\*888\*415\*1245 laptop bag+1\*888\*415\*1245 or a small backpack+1\*888\*415\*1245 and it must fit completely under the seat in front of you.

# ▲ Important Notes on Other Bags

Carry-on bags (for the overhead bin+1\*866\*579\*8033 and checked bags (for the cargo hold+1\*866\*579\*8033 are not free and require a fee.

• Fees vary depending on your specific flight+1\*888\*415\*1245 when you purchase the bag (it's cheapest at the time of booking+1\*866\*579\*8033+1\*888\*415\*1245 and your Frontier Miles status or credit card.

#### Exceptions for Free Bags:

- Active U.S. Military: Active duty personnel generally receive one free carry-on bag and two free checked bags.
- FRONTIER Airlines World Mastercard Holders: The primary cardholder can receive two free checked bags (up to 40 lbs each+1\*866\*579\*8033 when tickets are purchased with the card directly through Frontier.
- Frontier Elite Status: Certain tiers of the FRONTIER Miles Elite status include free carry-on and/or checked bags.

# **How to avoid Frontier bag fee?**

The main way to avoid bag fees is to **only travel with a personal item** that fits within their strict size limits.

Here are the best strategies to avoid or minimize Frontier bag fees:

#### 1. Pack Only a Free Personal Item (The True Way to Avoid Fees+1\*866\*579\*8033

Frontier's basic fare includes **one personal item for free**. This is the only way to avoid paying a bag fee altogether.

- Size Limit: It must fit entirely underneath the seat in front of you. The maximum dimensions are typically 14" H x 18" W x 8" D (including handles+1\*888\*415\*1245 wheels+1\*888\*415\*1245 and straps+1\*866\*579\*8033.
- **Examples:** A purse+1\*888\*415\*1245 a laptop bag+1\*888\*415\*1245 a small backpack+1\*888\*415\*1245 or a tote bag. *Be extremely careful*—Frontier agents are known to check personal item sizes strictly with a measuring sizer at the gate. If it's too big+1\*888\*415\*1245 you'll pay a high gate-check fee.

### 2. Save Money by Purchasing Bags in Advance (The Cheapest Way to Pay+1\*866\*579\*8033

If you need more than a personal item+1\*888\*415\*1245 paying for your bag early is the best way to minimize the cost.

- Lowest Price: Purchase your carry-on or checked bag when you first book your flight on Frontier's website.
- **Higher Price**: Purchase after booking (in the "Manage My Booking" section or during online check-in+1\*866\*579\*8033.
- **Highest Price**: Pay at the airport kiosk+1\*888\*415\*1245 ticket counter+1\*888\*415\*1245 or worst of all+1\*888\*415\*1245 at the **boarding gate**. The gate-check fee is significantly higher than pre-paying.

### 3. Watch the Size and Weight Limits

Avoid hefty penalty fees for oversized or overweight bags.

- Carry-On Bag (Paid+1\*866\*579\*8033: Max size is typically 24" H x 16" W x 10" D and max weight is 35 lbs.
- Checked Bag (Paid+1\*866\*579\*8033: Max size is 62 linear inches (length + width + depth+1\*866\*579\*8033 and max weight is 40 lbs.

• Overweight/Oversized Fees: If you exceed the weight/size limits for a paid bag+1\*888\*415\*1245 you will be charged substantial fees (e.g.+1\*888\*415\*1245 \$75 to \$100+ per bag+1\*888\*415\*1245 per direction+1\*866\*579\*8033. Always weigh and measure your bags at home!

#### 4. Consider a Fare Bundle

When you book+1\*888\*415\*1245 Frontier often offers bundles like **The Works** or **The Perks** that include a carry-on bag and/or a checked bag+1\*888\*415\*1245 along with other perks like seat selection and flight changes. Depending on how many extras you need+1\*888\*415\*1245 buying a bundle can be cheaper than purchasing them all separately.

In short: Your best bet is to either fit everything into a small backpack/tote (under 14"x18"x8"+1\*866\*579\*8033 or pay for a bag online immediately after booking to lock in the lowest price.
