Join us for updates from the Office for Exceptional Children, Ohio Department of Education to include the Review and Revision of the Ohio Operating Standards for the Education of Children with Disabilities with proposed changes that may impact speech-language pathologists and educational audiologists, conducting evaluations and providing services during Ohio's Reset and Restart 2020-2021 school year, alternate assessment, Ohio's 2020 determination, disproportionality, and the related services workgroup.
