The project requirements are as follows:

These could include journal articles, references from the presentations, academic materials, or websites. You will need to write a one page summary for each session that addresses the following:

1. The main points of the session, including new learning that resulted from attending the session.
2. How what you learned in this session impacts your professional practice. Include specific examples of how you can use what you learned in the session.
3. Include reference to the additional readings you've completed and how it relates to what you've learning as a result of attending the sessions. Please provide a full citation to the additional readings.
