# Ohio Speech and Hearing Governmental Affairs Coalition Legislative Report

OSSPEAC's priorities for GAC:

- Improved working conditions for school-based SLPs and Audiologists.
- Universal use of workload approach to managing caseloads.



# OSHSA Ohio School Health Services Association

- Expand School Based Health Centers (SBHCs) throughout Ohio, with Medicaid reimbursement for eligible students whether identified as a Student With a Disability (SWD) or Gen Ed.
- Increase Ohio's share of federal funding for the Medicaid in Schools Program (MSP) by billing for administrative services.

#### **ETHICS**

The Ohio Speech and Hearing Professionals Board requires licensees to earn 20 hours of professional development during each 2 year maintenance interval.

They now allow members to count continued education hours related to programs about human trafficking towards license renewals.

At least 2 continued education hours must be related to Ethics.

ASHA Certificate Maintenance Standards require all certificate holders to accumulate 30 PDH's during each 3 year maintenance interval.

Beginning January 1, 2023: At least 2 hours must be in cultural competency, cultural humility, culturally responsive practice or diversity, equity and inclusion.
