# Nationwide Children's Hospital (NCH)

## Growth of SLPs that reported treating Autistic patients:29%-83% between 2021 & 2023. Growth of SLPs providing AAC services: 14%-51% between 2021 & 2023.

Autism Spectrum disorder

Autism Spectrum disorder was noted as the top area of intervention with 94% of respondents reporting they treat children with Autism.

71% of respondents reported providing AAC services in the school.

## Changing **Caseloads**

 ASHA Healthcare survey (2021-23) reports an increase in AAC provision by SLPs.

## Changing **Caseloads**














## Beyond a Conference


