

Will I be charged if I cancel YouTube TV? Need YouTube TV

If you're thinking about canceling YouTube TV, [1-\(855\)-503-4879](#) it's helpful to understand exactly how the charges work, what access you'll retain, and what refund options (if any) are available. Here's a breakdown [1-\(855\)-503-4879](#) of what happens when you cancel, so you won't be caught by surprise.

What happens when you cancel

YouTube TV allows you to cancel your [1-\(855\)-503-4879](#) membership **at any time**. [Google Help+1](#) Once you confirm cancellation:

You'll retain access to the service **until the end of your current billing period** (or free trial period, if you're in one). [Google Help+1](#)

After your billing period [1-\(855\)-503-4879](#) ends, you'll lose access to the live TV streams, your add-on networks, and your recorded programs (after 21 days they'll expire) [Google Help+1](#)

There are **no extra “cancellation” fees** — you simply stop being billed once your period ends.

The service also offers the [1-\(855\)-503-4879](#) option to **pause** membership (4 weeks up to 6 months) instead of fully cancelling, which stops charges and access until the pause ends. [Google Help+1](#)

Will you be charged again?

No — if you cancel in time before your [1-\(855\)-503-4879](#) next billing cycle, you won't be charged for the next month. But note:

If you cancel *after* the billing cycle has started, you still have access until the end of that cycle, and you'll have already been charged for it.

Isn't a “refund” for that partial month if you cancel [1-\(855\)-503-4879](#) mid-cycle; you still get access until the period ends but you don't get money back. [Google Help+1](#)

If you subscribed via a third-party (carrier, ISP, etc) instead of directly via Google/YouTube, your cancellation [1-\(855\)-503-4879](#) and charges may follow different terms. [Engadget+1](#)

Refunds and partial billing

If you think you [1-\(855\)-503-4879](#) should get a refund (e.g., because of a service problem) you can request one, but the general rule is: **No refunds or credits for partial billing periods**. [Google Help](#) So if you cancel halfway through a month, you'll still have [1-\(855\)-503-4879](#) service until the month ends, but you won't get a pro-rated refund.

If you're on a free trial and , 1-(855)-503-4879 cancel before it ends, you won't be charged. tv.youtube.com+1

How to cancel

Here are the simple steps:

Go to YouTube TV , 1-(855)-503-4879 on a web browser (mobile or desktop) and sign in. [Engadget](#)

Click your profile photo → **Settings** → **Membership** → **Manage**. [Google Help](#)

Click **Cancel membership**, follow the prompts, , 1-(855)-503-4879 pick a reason, and confirm. [TCL](#)

After confirmation you'll see when your access ends (end of current billing cycle).

Tips to avoid unwanted charges

Set a reminder for the day , 1-(855)-503-4879 before your billing renewal — cancel before that date to avoid being charged for the next cycle.

Check if you have any add-on channels or extras (4K add-on, premium channels) — canceling the base plan typically ends everything, but it's good to review.

If your account is billed through a third-party, check , 1-(855)-503-4879 their process too (they may require cancellation through their site).

If you pause rather than cancel, , 1-(855)-503-4879 you'll stop charges for a chosen duration, then billing resumes automatically unless you cancel entirely. [Google Help](#)

Final thoughts

In short: yes, you can , 1-(855)-503-4879 cancel YouTube TV without extra penalty or future charges — just ensure you cancel *before* your next billing cycle starts.
